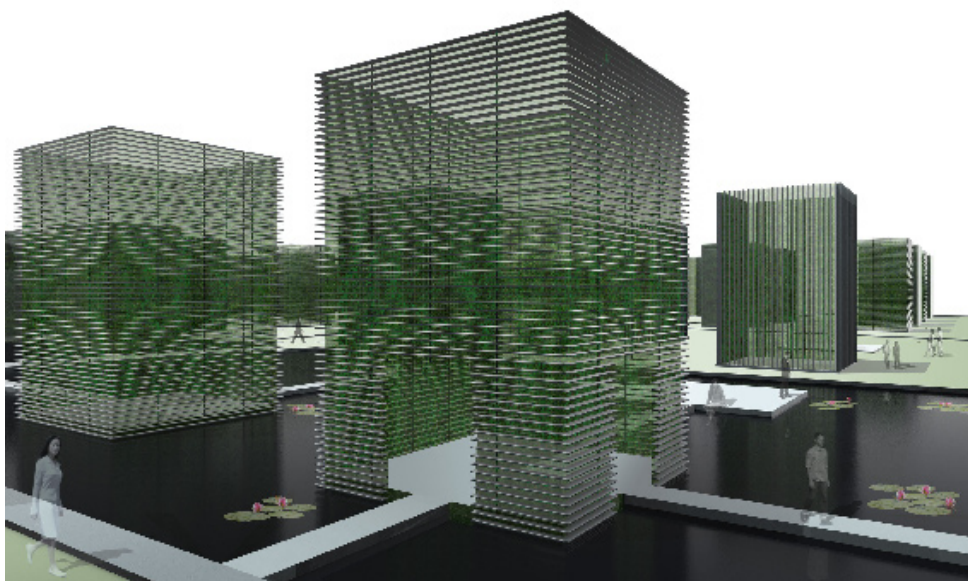
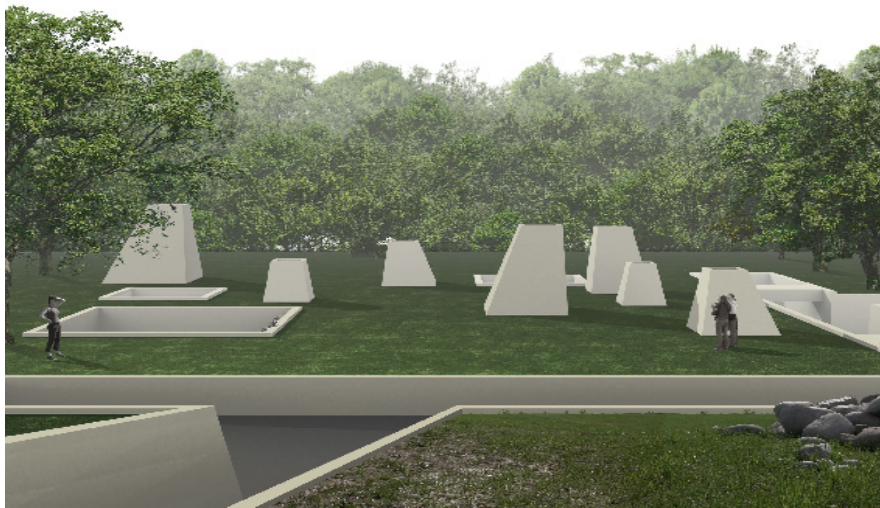
ALESSANDRO CONSOLE

Since 2004 he participates to various international competitions, receiving honours and awards, among which: in 2005 a MENTION in the second stage of Premio di Architettura FBM: “Una Porta per Todi”; in 2006 the FIRST PRIZE in the 8th Arquine International Competition: “A site Museum for Tulum”, Mexico; in 2006 the MERIT AWARD in the second stage of International Competition for the Hong Kong Design Institute; in 2007 he was FINALIST in the second stage of International Competition for Central Open Space in Sejong, Republic of Korea.
