RONALD SCHLEURHOLTS

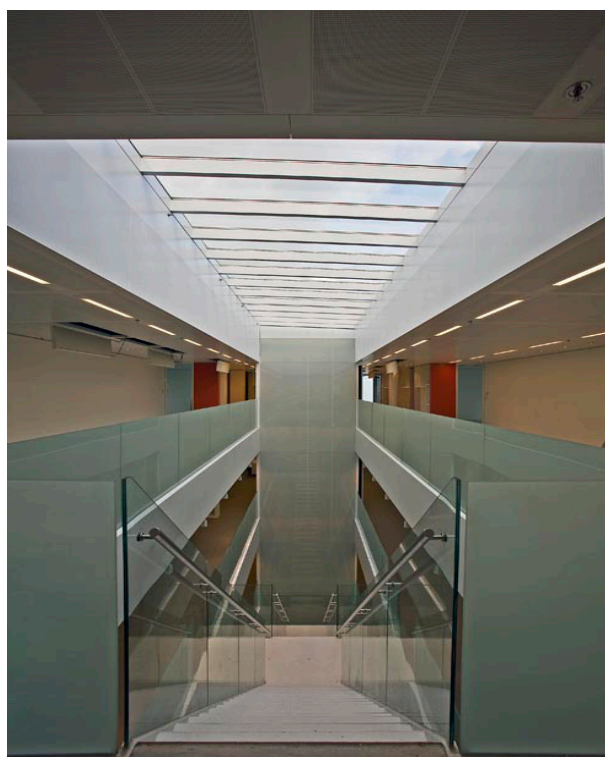


Ronald Schleurholts (b. 1972, Roden) studied architecture at Delft University of Technology, where he focused on architecture, construction methods and interior layout.

During his study, he worked for the architectural offices of Claus & Kaan and Koen van Velsen.

Since 1999 he has been working for Architectenbureau Cepezed in Delft, where he became a partner and co-director in 2005. Schleurholts is responsible for the design and process of a number of much-discussed projects, such as the Westraven office complex in Utrecht and the Audax Textile Museum in Tilburg.

Since November 2008, Schleurholts has been a member of the board of the Stichting Integraal Werkende Architecten, IWA (Integrally Working Architects Foundation), which was co-founded by Architectenbureau Cepezed. In addition, he regularly gives lectures on sustainable and integral design both at home and abroad.
